Re: Recognition of the International Arab Baccalaureate

I am very pleased to confirm that Cardiff University will consider applications from students presenting the International Arab Baccalaureate (IAB), for undergraduate programmes where there are no subject-specific requirements. All applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

A general grade equivalency to A-Level requirements is given below:

AAA - 93%

AAB - 90%

ABB - 87%

BBB - 84%
